Thanks, guys for all your hard work. We appreciate you for keeping our parsonage & grounds looking great!

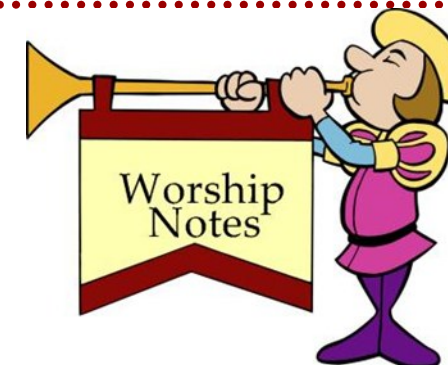


News from the Parsonage

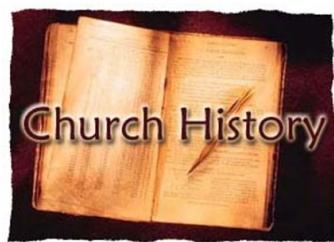

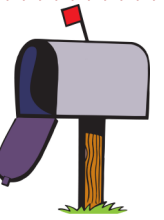

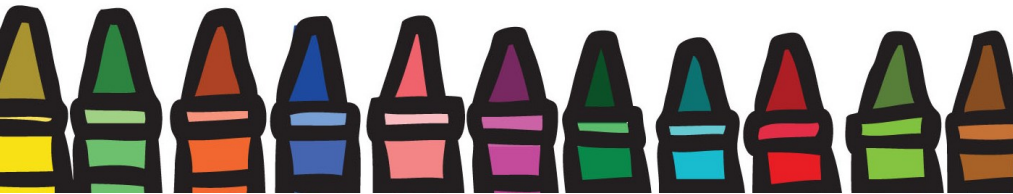
