"God's Not Dead; He's Surely Alive!"

Can I Get a Witness?

By Pastor Brian I often wear a silicone wristband that declares, "God's Not Dead" and most likely you have seen, or at least heard about, the two movies based on this statement of faith. The reason I bring this up is because many people have

noticed my wristband and some have even felt obliged to comment. I have heard things like "I hope so!" and "I'm not so sure!" which have led to opportunities for discussion and witnessing about the hope we have in Jesus.

Witnessing to others about the Lord is one of our most important callings, so much so that on my wristband there is also an accompanying Scripture reference, Matthew 10:32-33. This Scripture proclaims both Jesus' blessing and warning, "Whoever acknowledges Me before others, I will also acknowledge before My Father in heaven. But whoever disowns Me before others, I will disown before My Father in heaven."

These are strong words from the Lord reflecting the importance of our witness to the life-transforming grace and love of God that all believers, followers of The Way, disciples of Jesus Christ are called to share...with EVERYONE! After all, how will "they" know if we don't tell them, or better yet, show them by our love and example?

Now I know many who are concerned about how they go about sharing their faith, they don't know what to say. Jesus addresses that very concern when He tells His disciples in Matthew 10:19-20, "...do not worry about what to say or how to say it. At that time you will be given what to say, for it will not be you speaking, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you."

Wearing a silicone wrist band, a Christian tee shirt, or some other form of "witness wear" is a small beginning, possibly a conversation starter, but we need to be willing to go further, to talk, to actually allow the Holy Spirit to lead us into opportunities to share our faith. We just need to be honest with where we are in our walk with Christ and make sure we have a faith to share. We can't *profess* something we aren't sure we *possess*. The question becomes, "Is Christ really alive in me?"

The reason I pose this question is due to another comment I heard about the statement, "God's Not Dead." It came from one who said he "couldn't tell if this statement was true or not based on some of the "Christians" he knew!" I have to admit there was a time in my life as an early follower of Jesus that he could have been describing me, but thanks be to God for His faithfulness! I know God has given me new life through Jesus Christ because the Holy Spirit witnesses to my spirit that Jesus is alive in me! We all can have this assurance because Jesus gave His life willingly to show us, to tell us of God's amazing grace and love, to give us victory over sin, death and hell by overcoming the grave and rising to new life!

Now let me ask you, if you have been led by the Spirit to receive this gift of grace and have the assurance to know that indeed, God Is Not Dead, He Is Surely Alive, then isn't that something worth sharing?! Ask yourself, "Am I living in a way that witnesses to the truth that Jesus is alive and living in me?"

I am praying for all of us that we will be open to the Holy Spirit's leading and we will not keep the light of God's love under a bushel of our own making, but allow the Good News to permeate our hearts until it overflows in an evident, joy -filled praise we will just have to share! And when you do, remember Jesus' words from Acts 1:8, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."


JUST FOR FUN!

Fancy Flakes

Make a snowflake as unique and as special as you are in God's eyes.

What you need:

- paper (plain white or glittery wrapping paper)
- round plate or saucer (about the size you want your snowflake)
- pencil, crayon or marker
- scissors
- glitter
- glue stick
- hole punch






What you need to do:

- 1. Draw a circle on a piece of paper by tracing around the plate or saucer.
- 2. Cut out the circle.
- 3. Fold the paper in half three times. (If the paper is thick, fold it just twice.)
- 4. Use your scissors to carefully cut out shapes from the folded paper.
- 5. Unfold your paper.
- 6. On one side, write some things that are special about you.
- 7. Decorate the other side using the glue stick and glitter.
- 8. When the glitter is dry, punch a hole in the snowflake.
- 9. Put ribbon or yarn through the hole, and tie it to make a hanger.





- Adult help
- Washed fruit (watermelon, cantaloupe, strawberries, grapes)
- Knife and cutting board
- Small heart-shaped cookie cutter
- Bowl and spoon
- Mint leaves (optional)

What you do:

- 1. Slice the watermelon and use the cookie cutter to make heart shapes.
