

# Security improved & locks changed

June saw the Trustees upgrade Bethel's security by installing new locks across our facility. This was necessary as *hundreds* of keys to our buildings were in circulation. To stop this from occurring again, the Trustees (with full support of Admin. Council & Pastor) have issued new keys to key personnel (pun intended!) by church leadership position. For example, a key is issued to "Trustee Chair", not Bob Shugert. As Bethel leadership turns over, outgoing leaders must return in their key to Bethel.

Furthermore, keys cannot be duplicated locally—replacement keys must be ordered at a cost to Bethel. All current Committee heads, Trustees and certain other officers will be assigned keys after \$15 deposit is received, Deposit to be returned upon return of key. Again, all outgoing officers must return the key in order to be re-issued to new officer.

Furthermore, very few offices will be authorized to have a key. For special circumstances, guest keys may be signed out for a 48hour period with the Church Office Manager. Thanks for your patience and understanding!

The Christian Home Builders Class (Room S6) is now studying "The God We Can Know" by Rob Fuquay. Here is the schedule for the month of July.


Week 1 - "I Am the Bread of Life" - Knowing God's Satisfaction
