


NORTHMEN AND CATHY

NEWS FROM THE WORSHIP COMMITTEE



- Looking for a way to serve? We need 6 people (each taking 2 months) to sign up to help with Communion Sundays, which entails buying the communion bread, preparing the cups of juice and cleaning up/putting away after service. See Pastor Mona to serve ASAP.
- We have been utilizing Facebook live since January of this year. If you are camera shy, sit on the right side of the aisle as you come in, Pastor Mona has been coming off the platform to ask questions in the congregation and to keep her in the frame, the camera is panned.
- Help is always appreciated on the tech side- soundboard/graphics, Facebook live, etc. Training will be provided.
- For anyone planning to sing a special song that requires backing tracks, it is asked that the track is given to the tech no later than 30 minutes before service so it can be checked for quality, levels, etc. It's ideal if the person singing can be present so the tracks/vocals can be balanced. The soundboard can vary from day to day on levels, so a fresh balance will maximize the quality of the special song.
- Worship meetings will be held at Bethel on the first Wednesday of each month at 6 pm.
- Along with the Sunday message, we have feature called "Moment with God and Pastor Mona" It's a weekly devotional that you can find on the Facebook page!


